Harrison County General Health District (HCGHD) strives to provide public health excellence for the population of Harrison County. The health department serves the community through a variety of methods including health promotion, prevention, and protection as well as health education, nursing services, environmental health services, and emergency preparedness planning and response.

The following section outlines specific services available to the community.

Vital Statistics

HCGHD can issue Birth Certificates for anyone born in the state of Ohio. Death Certificates can be issued for anyone who was pronounced deceased in Harrison County.

Nursing

The Nursing department provides clinical services and health promotion activities to residents of Harrison County, such as immunizations and exercise classes. To schedule a vaccination appointment or for additional information related to infectious disease and health promotion activities, contact the Nursing Department at HCGHD.

Environmental

The Environmental department aims to reduce the rate of diseases transmitted through food, private water, septic, tattoos, body piercing, and other recreational programs. For any inquiries regarding food safety, animal bites, nuisance complaints, and septic systems in Harrison County, contact the Environmental department at HCGHD.

Emergency Preparedness

Public Health Emergency Preparedness involves planning for and responding to emergencies in Harrison County that pertain to public health. For questions regarding the health department's emergency response plan, contact the Preparedness Coordinator at HCGHD.

THE MENTAL HEALTH AND RECOVERY BOARD



(MHRB) is a public agency organized under Chapter 340 of the Ohio Revised Code and created to establish a unified system of mental health and addiction recovery services for citizens of Belmont, Harrison and Monroe Counties.

The Mental Health and Recovery Board (MHRB) is a branch of county government which is authorized and defined in the Ohio Revised Code, Section 340. It was created to establish a unified system of mental health and addiction recovery services for citizens of Belmont, Harrison and Monroe Counties. County boards do not provide direct clinical services, but rather purchase those services, primarily from local community agencies.

County boards are responsible to determine local needs, develop a community plan, set priorities, direct resources and monitor services in their district. This provides an opportunity to create integrated systems of care that are most responsive to the needs and desires of the local citizens. This is important because characteristics of counties vary widely and there is a mix of urban, suburban, and rural in Ohio that makes a "one-size-fits-all" approach particularly ineffective.

Our Community

The Mental Health and Recovery Board works through community partnerships to develop prevention, treatment, and recovery support services. Working with our local community providers to develop and provide services that are outcome oriented and prioritized for individuals and their family members. **Local community partners include:**

An algorithm reviews text for severity and messages that are determined to be from someone at imminent risk are placed at the top of the queue.

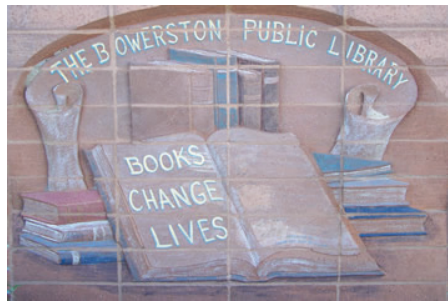
